\$12.8 Million in Prizes Won on Kansas Lottery Games During the Month of May

TOPEKA, KAN. – The Kansas Lottery announced \$12.8 million in prizes were won on games throughout the month of May. Of that, \$10.4 million was won on instant games, \$1.4 million was won on draw games and just over \$1 million was won on monitor games.

The Super Kansas Cash jackpot stood at \$325,000 to end the month, however, \$8,000 in top-tier prizes were won throughout May.

Below is the breakdown of the top-tier prize amounts won per region:

- Southeast Kansas: \$6,000
- North Central Kansas: \$2,000

In multi-state draw games, \$79,000 in top-tier prizes were won across the Sunflower State.

Below is a breakdown of the games and the top-tier amounts won per region:

- Powerball: \$50,000 won in top-tier prizes during May
 - South Central Kansas: \$50,000
- Lotto America: \$23,000 in top-tier prizes won during May
 - Northeast Kansas: \$22,000
 - South Central Kansas: \$1,000
- Mega Millions: \$6,000 in top-tier prizes won during May
 - Northeast Kansas: \$3,500
 - Southwest Kansas: \$2,500

In daily draw games, \$202,000 in prizes were won. Below is a breakdown by game and the top-tier amounts won per region:

- 2by2
 - Northeast Kansas: \$22,000
- Pick 3
 - Northeast Kansas: \$85,500
 - South Central Kansas: \$67,500
 - North Central Kansas: \$12,000
 - Southeast Kansas: \$9,000
 - Southwest Kansas: \$4,500
 - Northwest Kansas: \$1,500

The game Keno had \$647,048 in prizes won across the state and the game Racetrax had \$357,389 won in prizes.

The Kansas Lottery encourages its players to double-check their tickets since many of the top tier prizes remain unclaimed. Players have 365 days from the date of a drawing to claim their prize. For instant games, players have 180 days from the date a game ends to claim their prize.
