\$19.8 Million in Prizes Won on Kansas Lottery Games During the Month of April

TOPEKA, KAN. – The Kansas Lottery announced more than \$19.8 million in prizes were won on games during the month of April. Of that, \$10.3 million were won on instant games.

On draw games, \$8.5 million in prizes were won. In April, the Super Kansas Cash jackpot reached a record high. The nearly \$6.7 million jackpot was won in Northeast Kansas on April 17, 2019.

Throughout the month 22 other players matched the first five numbers, but not the Super Cash Ball winning a total of \$44,000 in top-tier prizes.

Below is the breakdown of the top-tier \$2,000 prize amounts won per region:

- Northeast Kansas: \$28,000
- Northwest Kansas: \$2,000
- North Central Kansas: \$0
- South Central Kansas: \$8,000
- Southeast Kansas: \$2,000
- Southwest Kansas: \$4,000

In multi-state draw games, \$461,000 in top-tier prizes were won across the Sunflower State.

Below is a breakdown of the games and the top-tier amounts won per region:

- Mega Millions: \$12,000 in top-tier prizes won during April
 - Northeast Kansas: \$2,000
 - South Central Kansas: \$10,000
- Lotto America: \$9,000 in top-tier prizes won during April
 - South Central Kansas: \$4,000
 - Southwest Kansas: \$2,000
 - Northeast Kansas: \$3,000
- Powerball: \$50,000 won in top-tier prizes during April
 - Northeast Kansas: \$50,000
- Lucky for Life: \$390,000 in top-tier prizes won during April
 - Northeast Kansas: \$390,000

In daily draw games, \$200,500 in prizes were won. Below is a breakdown by game and the top-tier amounts won per region:

- 2by2
 - South Central Kansas: \$22,000
- Pick 3
 - Northwest Kansas: \$0
 - North Central Kansas: \$6,000
 - Northeast Kansas: \$82,500
 - Southwest Kansas: \$29,500
 - South Central Kansas: \$52,000
 - Southeast Kansas: \$8,500

The game Keno had \$635,469 in prizes won across the state and the game Racetrax had \$357,790 won in prizes.

The Kansas Lottery encourages its players to double-check their tickets since many of the top tier prizes remain unclaimed. Players have 365 days from the date of a drawing to claim their prize. For instant games, players have 180 days from the date a game ends to claim their prize.
