RE: Extension of deadline for approval of Lottery Gaming Facility
manager contracts under the Kansas Expanded Lottery Act (SB 66)

Dear Governor Parkinson:

Earlier today a special meeting of the Kansas Lottery Commission (Commission) was convened during which the Commission considered an extension of the deadline for entering into and approving contracts with prospective Lottery Gaming Facility managers under the Kansas Expanded Lottery Act (SB 66) in the Northeast Gaming Zone and South Central Gaming Zone. The deadline for both Gaming Zones is currently June 30, 2009.

It is the opinion of the Commission that the Executive Director of the Kansas Lottery and the Commission have acted in good faith to comply with the 90-day deadline set forth in SB 66, New Section 3(d) (KSA 74-8734(d)), but due to a variety of factors the Lottery and all applicants agree an extension of the deadline is necessary. Pursuant to SB 66, New Section 5(f) (KSA 74-8736(f)), the Commission voted to apply to you for an extension of the deadline. Therefore, the Commission respectfully requests that you extend this Commission's deadline for entering into and approving contracts with all prospective Lottery Gaming Facility managers in both the Northeast Gaming Zone and the South Central Gaming Zone to no later than **August 28, 2009**.

Please note the Lottery Commission does not intend to utilize all of the time allotted by the extension requested, but in an abundance of caution is seeking the full 60-day extension.


