Bonner Springs Woman Wins \$25,000 Grand Prize in Riverfest Drawing: Other Players win Thousands of Dollars

TOPEKA, KAN. – Five finalists in the Kansas Lottery's Treasure Hunt Grand Prize Drawing Event came to the Wichita Riverfest this past weekend, each hoping to win a \$25,000 cash prize. In the end, it was Amber Lowe of Bonner Springs who took home the big money.

In the event held on stage outside Century II June 11, the crowd watched as the five finalists each picked one of five treasure chests. Only one chest contained the key that opened a box holding a \$25,000 check.

Although Amber Lowe won the \$25,000 prize, no one went home empty handed. Carol Bouska of Beloit and Shirley Branstetter of Wichita each won \$5,000 as second-place finishers. The other two finalists, Kelly Lowry of Plainville and Amy Wilds of Kansas City, Kan., each won \$1,000. The finalists became eligible for the Grand Prize Drawing Event by entering non-winning \$5 Treasure Hunt instant tickets into a May 27 drawing.

In a separate Kansas Lottery drawing at Wichita Riverfest June 11, Tom Smiley of Wichita won \$5,000 cash. Entries in that drawing were non-winning Treasure Hunt tickets deposited at Riverfest.
