Powerball Jumps to \$740 Million Ahead of Monday Night's Drawing

TOPEKA, KAN. – The Thanksgiving holiday may be over, but the excitement around the Powerball jackpot has still got everyone talking turkey. A \$740 million jackpot (\$346.1 million cash option) is up for grabs to kick off this snowy week back to work.

Powerball tickets start at just \$2, with the option to add the Power Play Multiplier and/or add Double Play to your ticket for an additional \$1 each. Powerplay can multiply a non-jackpot win by up to 10X.

Kansas Powerball tickets now have a option for an additional draw. The Double Play is a new Powerball feature that only 27 states currently offer that gives players another chance to match their Powerball numbers in a separate drawing with a top cash prize of \$10 million.

Additionally, the Kansas Lottery's annual Holiday Millionaire Raffle is rapidly approaching a sellout, as there are now less than 20,000 tickets remaining in the game! The final \$30,000 Early Bird drawing is this Sunday, December 7. Players are encouraged to get their tickets now to be eligible to win in all remaining drawings.
