First Triple Motor Mayhem Finalist Announced

TOPEKA, KAN. – The Kansas Lottery is congratulating the first three finalists in the Kansas Lottery’s Triple Motor Mayhem second-chance Finale Event drawing.

Marcus Fletcher of Topeka, Craig Doubrava of Kanopolis, and Josiah Jackson of Tecumseh are all in the running to win one of three 2019 Ford vehicle at the Triple Motor Mayhem second-chance Finale Event in Manhattan on October 26, 2019!

A total of 10 finalists will be selected with one lucky winner getting the chance to choose from one of the following vehicle options: 2019 Ford F-150 Raptor SuperCab, 2019 Ford Mustang GT Premium Convertible, or a 2019 Ford Expedition XLT. Each vehicle prize is valued at \$90,000, with state and federal taxes included. There is no cash option.
